



## Annual Report 2013 Honouring Eva Foundation

This annual report informs you about the 2013 activities of the Honouring Eva Foundation.

*The mission of the foundation is to support students who show great desire and passion for Core Energetics but do not have the financial means to enter or stay in the 2 year Transformation Training or the 4 year Practitioner Program at the Netherlands Institute Core Evolutionary. The support consists of (partial) scholarships and / or appropriate financing.*

Building on this goal we received in 2013 the tremendous support of € 24.406,31 from donators and from revenues out of different kind of activities. Further the foundation received an amount of €6.660 from the institute NICE, which reflects 5% of the total tuition fee of school year 2013 /2014. We were so encouraged by all donations that we could offer 15 scholarships (€24.830) and 2 loans (€ 3.000).

In 2013 we've made drastic changes in our course.

1. We formed a new board with Heleen de Winter, Nynke Sikkema, Melissa Alacheff, Bert Stek and Cees van Loon. Due to private reasons Melissa had to say goodbye to the board, Thank you so much, Melissa for your support, creativity and generosity!
2. We formulated new goals and plans like:
  - Making the Foundation more alive and visible in the community
  - Finding a new balance between helping and enabling students
  - Finding new creative ways and ideas to generate money
3. We got a commitment from the director of the school (NICE) to contribute 5% remittance each year from every student to the Scholarship Fund.
