Introduction

2022 has been a year of major changes for the Honouring Eva Foundation. In August we had to say goodbye to our beloved former chairman Cees van Loon. He passed away Monday 22nd of August. Cees co-founded the Foundation and has been part of the Committee through all its years. We also said goodbye to Bert and Riet. After years of dedication to the Foundation both of them felt it was time to move on, opening up space for new members.

In the past year the committee welcomed several new members. First of all, Christiaan Bramer, who, besides being one of the members, does also take on the role of chairman. Other members that we welcome are Marc Verheij, Tanja de Kleine, Didy Coljee and Peter Hettema. Peter does take the responsibility for the financial part of the Foundation. Together with Corinne and Wietse this new team will continue the work and will provide a new and fresh impulse.

There is more to share. 2022 has also been the year for publishing and launching our book on Eva Pierrakos. Corinne and Riet interviewed a large number of people on Eva's life and legacy. On Monday 22nd of August our beloved former chairman Cees passed away. Together with Melissa Alacheff he set up our Foundation, more than 10 years ago.

On the news of his passing she wrote:

“Cees brought his whole heart to his life and to his family, friends, and community. He gave himself generously and was a source of inspiration to many. He was often silent without words, but his presence spoke deeply and intensely. One could feel Cees. His presence was like a tree, solid with deep roots and wisdom. He lived with purpose and meaning and wanted to contribute and be a source of goodness in life. Of this, there is no doubt that he succeeded. He will be sorely missed, but his presence will still be felt by those whose lives he touched. Thank you, dear Cees, for ... everything. May you rest now in deep peace and with satisfaction over a life well-lived.”

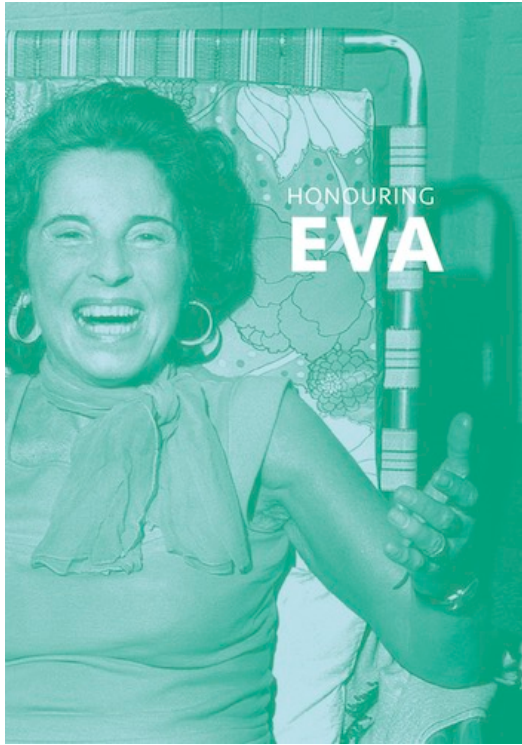

Honouring Eva Book

On 15th June 2022 the Foundation has proudly launched a unique on Eva Pierrakos.

Riet and Corinne created an extensive, chronological biography of Eva, including excerpts of her book *'The Path to the Real Self'* and parts from the remembrance book that was published after her passing in 1979.

Apart from the biography, it has become a book of interviews. Between April 2021 and March 2022 Riet and Corinne connected with a number of people who knew Eva in the flesh, who have worked with her in the Pathwork community in Phoenicia and New York. After that they spoke with people who are continuing and expanding The Pathwork and Core Energetics now, to people who, like her, have channeled beautiful and deep wisdom, and finally even with the entity that calls itself the Guide.

In 130 pages the story of Eva is told from many different perspectives, a story never told before in this distinctive way.
